



Dear Parent/Guardian,

Welcome to Garrison Academy for Cambridge Studies. We understand that you and your child are transitioning into a new system and scheme of studies under extremely difficult circumstances; understandably, there will be many questions in your mind with regard to CAIE and O' Level.

Usually, at this time an Open Day would be conducted to address aspects in detail and to facilitate subject selection; however, this is not possible in the presiding climate. In order to provide you and your child with a guideline, below are details of how we intend to proceed for this year:

- Students who have secured 70% or above in the APSACS final examinations for class 7 will be registered at GACS from 06th April 2020. Kindly note, only one adult is to visit the campus to complete the process, children, the elderly and those at high risk should remain at home. No admission test is required if the candidate has secured 70% or above. The school will contact individuals to arrange appointment times.
- Registration and admission will be deferred for students who have secured less than 70% in the APSACS final examination for class 7 until the school is given clearance to conduct admission tests (tentative date June 2020). All transfer cases must proceed through the parent campus your child is currently attending.
- Students seeking admission from external school systems will be able to register from 27th July 2020

APSACS Students with 70%+ Marks

- Transfer to GACS must proceed through your child's existing campus. Names and contact details will be forwarded by the school you are currently registered with. Once we receive your details Garrison Academy for Cambridge Studies will arrange an appointment time for registration.
- Upon registration the following documents need to be provided

- A prospectus number will be issued and fee challan will be generated
- Online classes for compulsory subjects (English Language, Urdu, Pakistan Studies, Islamiat and Mathematics) will begin from 4th May. These classes will engage students in developing skills and basic knowledge required for Cambridge Studies (CAIE/O' Level)



- Depending on prevailing circumstances, optional subject orientation and selection, will be held in May
- In keeping with CAIE timeline O' Level curriculum and syllabus break-up begins in August
- Optional/Elective subject selection will be based on the groups below, with humanities being added for the first time
